# Plant dyed pattern



We believe our bamboo frames give the lantern a heart and soul. Makino bamboo is used for these frames. Grown in the mountainous region of Taiwan, this pliable bamboo is highly durable. Where possible we always use natural and locally sourced materials


#### Note
